Here is the updated info of goings on in Whiffletree.

- Annual North Texas Food Bank (NTFB) Peanut Butter Drive kicks off on September 1. Be on the lookout for email going out just before 9/1 with the website address where you can make donation via credit card. We will also list a home in the neighborhood where you can drop off peanut butter or other nut butters, or a check made out to WHOA (we will consolidate all the money received via check and make 1 donation to NTFB PB Drive). We thank you in advance for your support of the many food-insecure families across North Texas.
- Reminder that also in September, we will be printing and distributing an updated Whiffletree Directory to all paid members of Whiffletree V/VI/VII. The Directory includes all kinds of information about Whiffletree and its residents as well as valuable info about the neighborhood and City of Plano services (another reason the pay dues)! - The Plano Metro Rotary Club places flags in front of homes throughout the area on many national holidays and is offering this service to Whiffletree neighbors. For \$50 annual subscription, much of which is donated to local charities, a 3' x 5' flag is placed in front of your house prior to the holiday and then removed after the holiday.
