- If you are a paid WHOA member, either this year or have already paid dues for upcoming year, and are interested in any of these positions or want to nominate someone for any board position (who is also a paid member), you may do so. Note that we will send electronic ballots to all paid members prior to the annual meeting that can be completed and submitted. In-person voting will also take place at Annual Meeting. Election of board positions and approval of annual budget is determined by simple majority of votes received. Note that we also

plan to include a speaker from City of Plano at the Annual Meeting to discuss issues of interest to Whiffletree residents. When we finalize the speaker and topic, we will share it with you.

- As we transition to 2026-2027 fiscal year, we will commence our annual membership drive. For the 4th year in a row, we are maintaining our annual WHOA dues unchanged at \$145 via check and \$150 via online payment to cover processing fees. Your board works hard to control expenses to keep dues low, which are lowest of any nearby neighborhood. We ask that you promptly pay your dues when you receive the invoice. We spend a sizable amount of time, money and effort to collect dues. This includes multiple mailings via USPS with cost for materials & postage, and door hangers, which required time and money to print and then hang on doors. Please, please pay your dues in timely fashion so that we can avoid all this extra time and cost to collect them. Thank you.
- We encourage all Whiffletree neighbors to review your current contact info that can be listed in the printed and online directory so that you can be promptly contacted in the event of an emergency with your home if you are away (burst pipe during freeze, malfunctioning sprinkler system and more).
